- Placed on Injured Reserve on 9/30/23
- Activated off the Non-Football Injury (NFI) list to the active roster on 11/1/22
- Designated for return from the Non-Football Injury (NFI) list on 10/12/22
- Placed on Non-Football Injury (NFI) list on 8/31/22
- David Ojabo was selected by the Ravens in the second round (45th overall) of the 2022 NFL Draft... Declared for the draft following his junior season at Michigan

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Appeared in three games (one start) for Baltimore in 2023, recording 6 tackles, 1 sack and 1 FF before being placed on season-ending Injured Reserve (knee)... Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Appeared in two games as a rookie in 2022 after being activated from NFI on 11/1/22... Tallied 1 sack and 1 FF on a strip-sack at Cin. (1/8/23)
- Recorded his first-career quarterback takedown and FF on a third-quarter strip-sack of Joe Burrow (recovered by ILB Patrick Queen) at Cin. (1/8/23)

— PERSONAL —

- Born in Nigeria and moved to Aberdeen, Scotland in 2007 before coming to the U.S. for high school
- Was a high school teammate of Ravens OLB Odafe Oweh at Blair Academy (Blairstown, NJ)... Originally grew up playing soccer and basketball, before transitioning to football his junior year of high school
- Won the 2018 Prep School State title in the 100-meter dash with a personal best time of 10.93 seconds
- Majored in English at Michigan
- **Last name is pronounced: oh-JOBB-oh**

**2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 3/1, 0/0, INJURED RESERVE)**

- Appeared in three games (one start), recording 6 tackles, 1 sack and 1 FF before being placed on season-ending Injured Reserve (knee)... Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)

- Contributed 3 solo tackles, 1 QBH and a fourth-quarter strip-sack – recovered by NT Michael Pierce – for a defense that permitted just 1 rushing first down and limited the Texans to 7-of-18 (38.9%) on third down and 1-of-4 (25%) on fourth down in the 25-9 season-opening victory vs. Hou. (9/10)... Became the first Raven to produce a strip-sack in back-to-back games (dating back to last season on 1/8/23 at Cin.) since OLB Matthew Judon (11/17/19 vs. Hou. – 11/25/19 vs. LAR)

**2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 2/0, 1/0)**

- Appeared in two games after being activated from NFI on 11/1... Tallied 1 sack and 1 FF on a strip-sack at Cin. (1/8/23)
- Recorded his first-career quarterback takedown and FF on a third-quarter strip-sack of Joe Burrow (recovered by ILB Patrick Queen) at Cin. (1/8/23)
- Saw action on defense and special teams in his NFL debut at Cle. (12/17)

— COLLEGE —

- Played in 20 career games (seven starts) at Michigan, where he recorded 36 tackles (25 solo), including 12 TFL, 11 sacks, 5 FFs, 1 FR and 3 PD... Helped lead Michigan to an appearance in the 2021 College Football Playoff semifinal against Georgia in the Orange Bowl
- Was part of a Wolverine's defense in 2021 that permitted the nation's eighth-fewest points per game (17.4) in 2021, also allowing the 16th-best opponent passer rating (118.4)
- In 2021, his 11 sacks tied for fourth most in Michigan's single-season record book, while his 5 FFs set a single-season school record
- His college honors include: second-team All-American by AP & CBS Sports (2021); first-team All-Big Ten by coaches and media (2021); Michigan's Most Improved Player, Defense (2021); second-team Academic All-American by CoSIDA (2021); Academic All-District 5 by CoSIDA (2021); two-time Academic All-Big Ten (2020-21)

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Prepped at Blair Academy (Blairstown, NJ), where he was a two-year starter at DE... Originally came to Blair Academy his sophomore year and participated in soccer and basketball before taking up football as a junior
- Produced 68 tackles, 14.5 sacks and 3 FFs in two seasons... As a senior in 2018, registered 33 tackles, 8.5 sacks and 1 FF
- In his first season playing organized football as a junior in 2017, recorded 35 tackles, 6 sacks and 2 FFs in seven games
- Earned 2018 Mid-Atlantic Prep League first-team and 2017 MAPL second-team All-Conference honors
