### — KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Isaiah Likely was selected by the Ravens in the fourth round (139th overall) of the 2022 NFL Draft... Was the fifth of six Ravens' picks (T Daniel Faalele, 110th; CB Jalyn Armour-Davis, 119th; TE Charlie Kolar, 128th; P Jordan Stout, 130th and CB Damarion Williams, 141st) in the round

### — CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Appeared in 17 games (eight starts) with Baltimore in 2023, posting 30 receptions for a career-high 411 yards and 5 TDs... Saw an increased role after TE Mark Andrews' Week 11 injury... He and Andrews were the NFL's only single-team pair of TEs with at least 5 TD grabs, while also becoming the first TE duo in Ravens history to accomplish the feat... Was part of a Baltimore TEs group that led the NFL with 12 receiving TDs... Contributed to an offense that ranked fourth in scoring (28.4 ppg) and No. 6 in total yards (370.4 ypg)
- Appeared in 16 games (two starts), registering 36 receptions for 373 yards and 3 TDs as a rookie in 2022... His 3 TD grabs tied Chigoziem Okonkwo and Jelani Woods for the most among NFL rookie TEs... Produced the most receptions (36), most TD receptions (3 – tied w/ Mark Andrews) and second-most receiving yards (373) by a rookie TE in Ravens history... Also notched the most receptions (8) and receiving yards (103) in a single game by a rookie TE in franchise history at Cin. (1/8/23)
- Produced a career-high 8 catches and 103 receiving yards at Cin. (1/8/23), with both figures also marking franchise single-game highs by a rookie TE
- Registered a 7-yard TD reception with :07 remaining in the first half, putting Baltimore ahead, 10-3, vs. Pit. (1/1/23)... Became the second rookie TE (Crockett Gillmore – 11/2/14) in Ravens history to record a TD reception in the storied Ravens-Steelers rivalry
- Became the first rookie TE in Ravens history to post a TD grab in back-to-back games when he capped an 11-play, 76-yard drive with a 24-yard TD reception in the 27-13 win at NO (11/7/22)
- Tallied then-career highs in receptions (6) and receiving yards (77), while recording his first-career TD (10-yard pass from QB Lamar Jackson), in the 27-22 win at TB (10/27/22)... His third quarter score in the back of the end zone gave Baltimore its first lead of the game – one on which it never relinquished

### — PERSONAL —

- Started playing football at age 4 and then picked up basketball in the fourth grade

- Joined close friend and high school teammate S Lewis Cine (Georgia) – who was selected 32nd overall by the Minnesota Vikings in the 2022 NFL Draft – as members of the 2017 Everett (MA) HS state championship team to become NFL draft picks
- Graduated with a degree in recreation and sport management from Coastal Carolina

### 2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/8, 2/1)

- Appeared in 17 games (eight starts), posting 30 receptions for a career-high 411 yards and 5 TDs... Saw an increased role after TE Mark Andrews' Week 11 injury... He and Andrews were the NFL's only single-team pair of TEs with at least 5 TD grabs, while also becoming the first TE duo in Ravens history to accomplish the feat... Was part of a Baltimore TEs group that led the NFL with 12 receiving TDs... Contributed to an offense that ranked fourth in scoring (28.4 ppg) and No. 6 in total yards (370.4 ypg)
- Tallied 2 catches for 34 yards and his first-career postseason TD, a 15-yard grab that extended Baltimore's lead, in the 34-10 Divisional Playoff win vs. Hou. (1/20/24)
- Registered 2 receptions for 31 yards and 1 TD in the regular season finale vs. Pit. (1/6/24)
- Totaled 2 catches – both TDs – for 42 yards, notching the first multi-TD game of his young career in the No.-1-seed-clinching 56-19 win vs. Mia. (12/31)... His first score required only one hand, snagging it out of the air on a crucial fourth-and-7 attempt and turning up the sideline for a 35-yard TD
- Registered 3 receptions for 56 yards, including a 34-yard reception, in the 33-19 win at SF (12/25)
- Registered 5 receptions for a team-high 70 yards and 1 TD, marking his second-consecutive game reaching the end zone, in the playoff-clinching 23-7 win at Jax. (12/17)... Posted a 16-yard TD grab and a 26-yard jump ball at the Jaguars' 4-yard line to help set up a TD that further extended the lead
- Registered 5 catches for a season-high 83 yards and 1 TD in the 37-31 OT win vs. LAR (12/10)... His career-long 54-yard scoring grab marked his first TD of the season
- Started at TE in place of the injured Mark Andrews, registering a team-high 40 yards on 4 catches in the 20-10 win at LAC (11/26)
- Tallied 4 receptions for season-high 42 yards, including 2 grabs that moved the chains on third down, in the 37-3 win vs. Sea (11/5)

## 2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/2, 1/0)

- Appeared in 16 games (two starts), registering 36 receptions for 373 yards and 3 TDs...His 3 TD grabs tied Chigoziem Okonkwo and Jelani Woods for the most among NFL rookie TEs...Produced the most receptions (36), most TD receptions (3 – tied w/ Mark Andrews) and second-most receiving yards (373) by a rookie TE in Ravens history...Also notched the most receptions (8) and receiving yards (103) in a single game by a rookie TE in franchise history at Cin. (1/8/23)
- Produced a career-high 8 catches and 103 receiving yards at Cin. (1/8/23), with both figures also marking franchise single-game highs by a rookie TE
- Registered a 7-yard TD reception with :07 remaining in the first half, putting Baltimore ahead, 10-3, vs. Pit. (1/1/23)...Became the second rookie TE (Crockett Gillmore – 11/2/14) in Ravens history to record a TD reception in the storied Ravens-Steelers rivalry
- Became the first rookie TE in Ravens history to post a TD grab in back-to-back games when he capped an 11-play, 76-yard drive with a 24-yard TD reception in the 27-13 win at NO (11/7)
- Tallied then-career highs in receptions (6) and receiving yards (77), while recording his first-career TD (10-yard pass from QB Lamar Jackson), in the 27-22 win at TB (10/27)...His third quarter score in the back of the end zone gave Baltimore its first lead of the game – one on which it never relinquished
- Posted 4 receptions for 43 yards vs. Mia. (9/18)...Hauled in his first-career catch for a 34-yard gain that later set up WR Demarcus Robinson's 12-yard TD grab to increase Baltimore's lead just before halftime

### — COLLEGE —

- Was a three-year starter at Coastal Carolina (2019-21), splitting his snaps between slot/outside and inline TE...In 48 career games (27 starts), registered 133 catches for 2,050 yards (15.4 avg) and 27 TDs

- Started all 13 games as a senior in 2021, finishing No. 2 among FBS TEs in receiving yards (912) and TDs (12) on 59 catches, en route to earning second-team All-American and first-team All-Sun Belt Conference honors...Was also a semifinalist for the John Mackey Award, given annually to college football's most outstanding TE
- Saw action in 11 games (eight starts) in 2020, posting 30 receptions for 601 yards (20.0 ypc) and 5 TDs, en route to first-team All-Sun Belt honors...Led all FBS TEs with a 20.0 yards-per-catch average
- Appeared in 12 games (six starts) as a sophomore in 2019, tallying 32 receptions for 431 yards and 5 TDs, en route to earning third-team All-Sun Belt honors
- Saw action in all 12 games during his freshman year (2018), recording 12 catches for 106 yards and tying for the team lead with 5 TDs
- His college honors include: second-team All-American by the FWAA (2021); first-team All-Sun Belt Conference (2020-21); John Mackey Award (nation's top TE) semifinalist (2021); honorable mention All-American by *Phil Steele* (2021); Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week (Week 6); third-team All-Sun Belt Conference (2019); Sun Belt Conference Academic Honor Roll (2018-19)

### — HIGH SCHOOL —

- Graduated from Everett (MA) HS, where as a senior in 2017, he earned All-State honors at WR (10 TDs), leading the team to a 12-0 record and the 2017 Division I State Championship
- Became a starting WR as a junior at Malden (MA) HS, posting 59 catches for 917 yards and 11 TDs, leading the team to the Division I State Championship
- Originally attended Malden (MA) HS, where he played RB as a freshman and safety as a sophomore
- Also lettered in basketball
