— KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Signed a one-year contract with Baltimore on 3/21/24
- Acquired by the Houston Texans from the Cardinals on 8/24/23 in exchange for a 2024 fifth-round pick
- Originally selected by the Arizona Cardinals in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2020 NFL Draft

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Played in 13 games (three starts) with the Texans in 2023, while also seeing action in both playoff contests...Protected on a line that helped rookie QB C.J. Stroud finish the regular season as the NFL's leader in passing yards per game (273.9) and TD-to-INT ratio (4.60)...Helped the offense post the fewest giveaways in the league (14) and tally the second-most pass plays over 25 yards (41)...Also saw snaps on special teams, helping the unit finish first in Rick Gosselin's "NFL Special Teams Rankings" for the second consecutive season
- Saw time in all 17 games (nine starts at LT) with the Cardinals in 2022...Started nine of the last 10 contests of the season, including his first of the year at Min. (10/30)...Played in the Cardinals' historic 29-23 OT victory at LV (9/18), marking the franchise's first-ever win after trailing by 20+ points
- Appeared in all 17 games (12 starts) with the Cardinals in 2021, while also seeing action in the Wild Card Playoff at LAR (1/17/22)...Started nine games at RG and three at RT...Helped the Cardinals to an 11-6 regular season record (including a 7-0 start) and a franchise-best 8-1 mark on the road...Cardinals committed just 15 turnovers – which marked the fewest in team history – and netted 4,000+ passing (4,276) and 2,000+ (2,076) rushing yards for just the second time in franchise history (also 1984)
- Played in 13 games on offense and special teams during his rookie campaign with the Cardinals (2020)...Helped the offensive unit finish Top 10 in total offense (No. 6 – 384.6), rushing yards per game (No. 7 – 139.8), rushing TDs (No. 4 – 22) and offensive TDs (No. 10 – 49)...Blocked for a unit that posted 6,153 yards of total offense and 410 points (third and fifth-most, respectfully, in franchise history)...Made his NFL debut in Week 2 vs. Was. (9/20)

2023: (HOUSTON TEXANS - 13/3, 2/0)

- Played in 13 games (three starts) with the Texans in 2023, while also seeing action in both playoff contests...Protected on a line that helped rookie QB C.J. Stroud finish the regular season as the NFL's leader in passing yards per game (273.9) and TD-to-INT ratio (4.60)...Helped the offense post the fewest giveaways in the league (14) and tally the second-most pass plays over 25 yards (41)...Also saw snaps on special teams, helping the unit finish first in Rick Gosselin's "NFL Special Teams Rankings" for the second consecutive season
- Saw extensive time on special teams in the Wild Card Playoff vs. Cle (1/13/24) and Divisional Playoff at Bal. (1/20/24)
- Started two games at LT (9/17 vs. Ind. and 9/24 at Jax.) after his Texans debut at LG (9/10 at Bal.)

2022: (ARIZONA CARDINALS - 17/9)

- Saw time in all 17 games (nine starts at LT)...Started nine of the last 10 contests of the season, including his first of the year at Min. (10/30)
- Blocked for RB James Conner vs. TB (12/25) as he scored a TD in his sixth-consecutive game, tying for the third-longest streak in franchise history
- Started at LT at LAR (11/13) for a unit that held All-Pro DT Aaron Donald to just one QB pressure
- Saw action on special teams in the 26-16 win at Car. (10/2), which marked the team's first regular season road victory against the Panthers since 2002
- Played in the Cardinals' historic 29-23 OT victory at LV (9/18), marking the franchise's first-ever win after trailing by 20+ points

2021: (ARIZONA CARDINALS - 17/12)

- Appeared in all 17 games (12 starts) with the Cardinals, while also seeing action in the Wild Card Playoff at LAR (1/17/22)...Started nine games at RG and three at RT...Helped the Cardinals to an 11-6 regular season record (including a 7-0 start) and a franchise-best 8-1 mark on the road...Cardinals committed just 15 turnovers – which marked the fewest in team history – and netted 4,000+ passing (4,276) and 2,000+ (2,076) rushing yards for just the second time in franchise history (also 1984)
- Started at RT and played every offensive snap at Dal. (1/2/22), helping the unit post its eighth road win of the year, which marked a franchise single-season record
- Played every snap for an offensive unit that led the NFL in points scored (140) through Week 4 at LAR (10/3)

- Started at RT for the NFL's only offense to score 30+ points in each of its first three games of the season at Jax. (9/26)
- Made his first career start (at RG) for an offense that posted 38 points (a season high) and 414 yards of total offense at Ten. (9/12)...Protected QB Kyler Murray, who tied his career-high with 4 passing TDs

2020: (ARIZONA CARDINALS - 13/0)

- Played in 13 games on offense and special teams during his rookie campaign with the Cardinals...Helped the offensive unit finish Top 10 in total offense (No. 6 – 384.6), rushing yards per game (No. 7 – 139.8), rushing TDs (No. 4 – 22) and offensive TDs (No. 10 – 49)...Blocked for a unit that posted 6,153 yards of total offense and 410 points (third and fifth-most, respectfully, in franchise history)
- Helped the offense gain a season-best 526 total yards vs. Phi. (12/20)
- Played 13 snaps for an offense that totaled 400+ yards and 30+ points for the fourth-consecutive game vs. Mia (11/8)
- Saw time on offense at Dal. (10/19), helping Arizona score a season-high 38 points and gain 438 total yards, including a season-best 261 on the ground
- Made his offensive debut at Dal. (10/19) and NFL debut in Week 2 vs. Was (9/20)

— COLLEGE —

- Started all 45 games he appeared in at LT for Houston (2016-19), earning American Athletic second-team All-Conference honors in 2019...Named a team captain as a senior
- Allowed just 18 pressures while playing 1,282 pass-blocking snaps in his final three seasons

- Started all nine games he appeared in as a senior in 2019, en route to earning American Athletic All-Conference second-team honors for allowing just 1 sack and 3 QB hurries on the year...Given a 93.2 grade by PFF for the season, which was the highest grade ever given to a collegiate offensive tackle, and named to the Outland Trophy Watch List before the year
- As a junior in 2018, started all 13 games and blocked for an offense that finished the season ranked fifth nationally in scoring offense (43.9 ppg), seventh in total offense (512.5 ypg), 16th in passing offense (295.5 ypg) and 24th in rushing offense (217.1 ypg)...Named an Athlon Sports Preseason American Athletic Conference second teamer
- Started all 10 games he appeared in as a sophomore in 2017, helping the Cougars to 2,002 yards and 25 TDs on the ground...Named an *Athlon Sports* Preseason American Athletic Conference fourth teamer
- As a redshirt freshman in 2016, was the only offensive lineman to start and play in all 13 games...Led the team with 931 snaps and 38 knockdown blocks while playing an integral role in Houston's 1,912 yards and 29 TDs on the ground
- Redshirted as a true freshman in 2015

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Prepped at George Bush (Richmond, TX) HS where he was a three-star recruit, two-time All-District selection and named a Top 100 player in the state by multiple publications
- Earned first-team All-District and All-Vype team honors in 2013 after helping lead the Broncos to a 9-3 record
- Named second-team All-District as a sophomore after helping the Broncos to a 10-2 season
- Also played basketball, helping the team to the regional finals while playing alongside current Golden State Warriors small forward Kelly Oubre Jr.
