— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- As a rookie in 2023, appeared in eight games (two starts) for the Ravens before a season-ending knee injury in Week 15...Totaled 47 carries for 396 yards (8.4 avg.) and 2 TDs, while adding 9 receptions for 93 yards...His 8.4 yards-per-carry average led the entire league and was the highest single-season average by a RB in NFL history (min. 40 attempts)...Contributed to the NFL's No. 1 rushing offense (156.6 ypg) and No. 4 scoring offense (28.4 ppg)...The ground game eclipsed 100 yards in all 17 contests, while also setting a single-season franchise record with 26 rushing TDs

— PERSONAL —

- Father (Anthony) played collegiately at Tuskegee and earned a roster spot with the Baltimore Ravens as an undrafted free agent in 2000...Was a reserve during the Ravens' Super Bowl XXXV championship season...Returned a blocked FG 90 yards for a TD in the 24-10 win at Tennessee in the Divisional Playoff (1/7/2001)
- Has received advice from and maintained a relationship with former three-time Pro Bowl running back Chris Johnson, who also played at East Carolina...His "go-to" advice for Mitchell is "Keep your speed. That's your most deadly weapon."
- Mother, Kandice, played football as a LB for the Atlanta Phoenix of the Women's National Football Conference
- Brother, Kobi, played DB and ran track for Tuskegee from 2019-21
- Has played RB since he was 6 years old...Cites his agility, moves and footwork from playing soccer at a young age
- Played rec football with 2023 Texans first-round pick LB Will Anderson
- Wanted to run track at East Carolina, but his football coaches would not allow it
- Loves handy work, and spends his free time fixing basements with father, Anthony

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 8/2, 0/0, INJURED RESERVE)

- Appeared in eight games (two starts) before a season-ending knee injury in Week 15... Totaled 47 carries for 396 yards (8.4 avg.) and 2 TDs, while adding 9 receptions for 93 yards...His 8.4 yards-per-carry average led the entire league and was the highest single-season average by a RB in NFL history (min. 40 attempts)...Contributed to the NFL's No. 1 rushing offense (156.6 ypg) and No. 4 scoring offense (28.4 ppg)...The ground game eclipsed 100 yards in all 17 contests, while also setting a single-season franchise record with 26 rushing TDs
- Posted 9 carries for 73 yards (8.1 avg.), while adding 2 receptions for 15 yards, before leaving the game in the fourth quarter with a season-ending knee injury in the playoff-clinching 23-7 win at Jax. (12/17)
- Posted 54 yards on 9 carries (6.0 avg.), while adding an 8-yard reception, in the 37-31 OT win vs. LAR (12/10)...Posted his fifth-straight game with a 20-plus-yard rush (27-yarder in the third quarter)
- Made his first-career start at RB, rushing for a team-high 64 yards on 9 carries (7.1 avg.), while adding 2 receptions for 25 yards in the 20-10 win at LAC (11/26)...Posted his fourth-straight game with a rush of 20-plus yards, tying QB Lamar Jackson (2018) for the longest streak by a Ravens rookie in franchise history
- Recorded a 39-yard rushing TD on the Ravens' opening offensive possession and later added a 32-yard reception vs Cle. (11/12)...Became the first Raven ever and first NFL undrafted rookie since at least 2000 to post rushing TDs of at least 35 yards in consecutive games
- Posted a team-high 138 rushing yards, including a game-long 60-yard run, on 9 attempts (15.3 avg.) in his third-career NFL contest in the 37-3 win vs. Sea. (11/5)...The rushing attempts marked the first of his career, as he contributed to an attack that posted a season-best 298 ground yards and 3 TDs...His 138 rushing yards are the highest single-game total by an undrafted rookie in Ravens history...Became the NFL's first undrafted player and rookie RB, respectively, since the 1970 merger to register at least 130 rushing yards on fewer than 10 carries...Baltimore's 298 rushing yards marked the fourth-best single-game output in franchise history

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- ECU's career leader in rushing yards per game (91.7) and rushing yards per carry (6.54)
- Set ECU's program record for consecutive 100-yard rushing games (seven – 2022), in total tallying a single-season program record nine games going over the century mark in rushing yards
- Ranks third all time in program history in rushing yards (3,027) and 100-yard rushing contests (15)
- Did not have a fumble in 462 career carries at ECU
- As a junior in 2022, started all 12 games, rushing for 1,452 yards and 14 rushing TDs, adding 1 receiving TD...Tied (vs. Tulane) for a career-high 222 rushing yards at Temple...Also had 100-yard rushing games vs. Old Dominion (160), vs. Campbell (185), vs. Memphis (149), vs. UCF (105), at BYU (176), at Cincinnati (112), vs. Houston (128) and vs. Coastal Carolina (127) in the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl
- As a sophomore in 2021, started all 12 games and led the league in total rushing yards (1,132) and all-purpose yards per game (115.83)...Tallied four 100-yard rushing games, including tying for (at Temple) a career-high 222 yards vs. Tulane...Also registered 22 receptions for 253 yards and 1 TD...Ranked ninth in the nation in rushing yards per attempt (6.5)...Scored a TD on an 88-yard rush at Marshall, the longest rush of his career and fourth-longest rush in program history
- As a freshman in 2020, appeared in nine games (two starts), rushing for over 100 yards twice (124 – at Cincinnati and at Temple)
- Prepped at Eagle's Landing Christian Academy (Stockbridge, GA), where he led the football team to four straight Georgia Class A Private championships and a combined 54-2 overall record (27-1 region) during his career
- Rushed for a combined 4,347 yards (155.3 ypg) and 88 TDs as a full-time starter during junior and senior years
- Led the Chargers (13-1, 6-1) to the 2019 state title...Rushed for 1,838 yards and 39 TDs on 192 carries (8.7 avg.)...Totaled 2,672 all-purpose yards (13-527 on KORs & 7-145 on PRs)...Named Class A Region 5 Player of the Year by the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution*
- Key member of a team that claimed the state championship in 2018...Rushed for 2,509 yards (213 carries) and 49 TDs as a junior, accounting for 2,544 all-purpose yards...His TD total was the second-highest single-season mark in state history (per the Georgia High School Football Historians Association), only ranking behind by Emanuel County's Washaun Ealey (58) in 2007 but ahead of 1982 Heisman Trophy winner Herschel Walker's 45...Earned 2018 Offensive Player of the Year honors (Class A Private classification) from the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution* and was also named to the *AJC's* Southside All-Metro squad
- Rushed for 979 yards and 20 TDs on 94 carries during sophomore season...Helped cap Eagles Landing Christian's perfect 14-0 campaign with a 41-3 triumph over Athens Academy in the state title clash
- Posted 37 rushes for 368 yards and 6 TDs as a freshman in 2016
