### — COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS —

- Appeared in 31 games (19 starts), primarily at RT, during his four-year career (2020-23) at Washington...Helped the team attain a 14-1 mark (undefeated in the regular season), win the Pac-12 Championship and reach the College Football National Championship in his final season (2023)
- Blocked for left-handed QB Michael Penix Jr. (2022-23), serving as the blindside protector for the 2023 Maxwell Award Winner (which is presented to the best player in college football), 2023 Heisman Trophy finalist and 2022 *AP* Comeback Player of the Year
- Never gave up a sack during his collegiate career

### — PERSONAL —

- Was a two-sport athlete (football and basketball) at Valor Christian...Also played baseball as a kid
- Worked out in the concourse of Husky Stadium when the team was unable to use the locker room and practice field before the 2020 season due to COVID restrictions
- Moved to RT his last two years at UW to protect left-handed QB Michael Penix Jr.'s blindside
- Ran the fastest 40-yard dash of any offensive lineman at the 2024 Combine (4.92)
- Listed the highest-ranked offensive line prospect to sign with Washington in over a decade

- Played basketball, soccer, baseball and flag football before he took up football...The summer before high school, his baseball team made it to the Colorado USSSA state championship game...Coached by former Denver Broncos Ben Hamilton and Tyler Polumbus in high school

- Has a sister, Brittany

#### 2023: (WASHINGTON – 15/15)

- Started at RT in all 15 games for the Huskies, helping the team attain a 14-1 mark (10-0 in conference play), win the Pac-12 Championship and reach the CFP National Championship in his final season (2023)...Served as the blindside blocker for left-handed QB Michael Penix Jr. (Maxwell Award Winner and Heisman Trophy finalist), who led college football in passing yards (4,903) and ranked third in passing TDs (36)...The Huskies' offense ranked second in passing offense (343.7 ypg) and tied for sixth in sacks allowed (12) nationally
- Started at RT in the CFP National Championship vs. Michigan (1/8/24)
- Started at RT in the Allstate Sugar Bowl victory vs. Texas (1/1/24), blocking for a unit that posted 25 first downs and 532 total yards of offense (430 passing)
- Started at RT in the Pac-12 Championship vs. Oregon (12/1), paving the way for UW's run game to register 157 yards and 2 TDs
- Started at RT at USC (11/4), helping the unit record 572 total yards (316 rushing and 256 passing), as well as 7 total TDs (5 rushing and 2 passing)
- Started at RT at Michigan State (9/16), protecting QB Michael Penix Jr. who finished with a season-high 536 passing yards and 4 passing TDs
- Started at RT in the 56-19 victory vs. Boise State (9/2)

#### 2022: (WASHINGTON – 13/13)

- Started at RT in all 13 games as a junior, helping the Huskies to an 11-2 record and an Alamo Bowl victory vs. Texas (12/29)...UW's offense ranked second nationally in passing yards (343.7 ypg) eighth in scoring (38.7 ppg) and 12th in total yards (462.1 ypg)
- Started at RT in the Alamo Bowl vs. Texas (12/29), contributing to an offense that posted 445 total yards (287 passing and 158 rushing)

## — HIGH SCHOOL —

- Started at RT at Washington State (11/26), blocking for the pass game to accumulate 485 yards and 3 TDs, while also helping the run game post 218 yards and 4 TDs in the Apple Cup rivalry
- Started at RT vs. Arizona (10/15), helping the unit post a season-high 516 yards and 4 TDs through the air in the 49-29 victory
- Started at RT vs. Portland State (9/10), paving the way for a dominant 617 total yards of offense (376 passing and 241 rushing) and 7 total TDs (2 passing and 5 rushing)
- Made his first start for the Huskies vs. Kent State (9/3), earning the coaches' Offensive Power Player of the Week following his performance

- Attended Valor Christian (Denver, CO) HS where he was a three-sport athlete (football, basketball and baseball)...Lettered in both football (four years) and basketball (two years)...Began as a tight end before switching to the offensive line his junior year of high school, when Ed McCaffrey, former Stanford and longtime NFL WR, took over as Valor's head coach...Amassed over 100 tackles in 48 career games...Won a pair of state titles in football (2016 and 2018)...Averaged 15.6 points and 7.6 rebounds per game as a junior on the basketball team, earning honorable mention 5A All-State in basketball
- Selected to play in the 2020 Polynesian Bowl and the 2020 All-American Bowl
- Named to the *Tacoma News-Tribune's* "Western 100" in 2020
- Helped lead the Eagles to a 10-2 record and a trip to the state 5A quarterfinals as a senior in 2019
- Earned Class 5A first-team All-State on the defensive line and first-team Colorado Community Media All-South Metro as a junior in 2018
- Listed as the No. 85 recruit and No. 9 offensive tackle in the country, as well as the No. 1 player in Colorado, by *247Sports*...Rated the No. 128 overall prospect and No. 14 tackle, as well as Colorado's No. 2 recruit, by *com*...Ranked the No. 25 tackle and No. 3 recruit in the state by *ESPN*

### 2021: (WASHINGTON – 4/0)

- Appeared in four games during the 2021 season (vs. Washington State, 11/26; at Colorado, 11/20; at Michigan, 9/11; vs. Montana, 9/4), maintaining a year of eligibility

### 2020: (WASHINGTON – 1/0)

- Appeared in one game as a true freshman, a 44-27 victory vs. Arizona (11/21), in the pandemic-shortened season

- Visited the St. Paul's School for an afternoon of fellowship and fun with Next One Up...Rookies and students were divided into three groups, rotating between kickball, silent charades and "anything but football" conversations (2024)
- Participated in the organization-wide Signature Build Day at Samuel Coleridge-Taylor Elementary School...Throughout the day, close to 200 volunteers made up of current and former Ravens players, staff and executives refurbished the school's gymnasium, classrooms, teachers' lounges and hallways...Additionally, volunteers renovated the playground and outdoor courtyard, planted trees and painted outdoor murals to enhance landscaping and enrich the school community (2024)
